## Core Grade 10 Courses


#### Abstract

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY BEFORE MAKING COURSE SELECTIONS: A student who has achieved a mark of $50 \%$ or higher in a given course is eligible to take the next or higher ranking high school course in that sequence. Going from grade 9 to grade 10, it is recommended that a student have at least an 80 percent average in a grade 9 core course (such as English Language Arts) if they wish to take the Enhanced Academic Programming(EAP) at the grade 10 level, offered in preparation for Advanced Placement in grades 11 and 12. Please check mark your course of choice. Note that if a student does not have high enough marks for AP, they may not be eligible. Check with your school counsellor if you are unsure.

Offering these courses will depend on student interest and their availability within the schedule. Once the full academic schedule of each student is determined, possible complementary courses will be added based on consultation with the school counsellor.
