Advent

The word advent comes from the Latin word meaning "coming", as the birth of the Lord is coming and this is the time of the year that we celebrate His coming and during Advent, we recall the history of God's people.

We use the advent wreath as a symbol and reminder of our waiting to celebrate the birthday of Jesus.

The green boughs of the wreath symbolize life and this is a reminder that the love God has for each and everyone of us never changes. The circle of the wreath indicates there is no beginning and no end and a reminder also that our life with God never ends.

The advent wreath has four candles around it -3 purple and one pink. The four candles represent the four weeks in Advent where the three purple typically represent hope, love and peace and the pink one represents joy, the joy we experience as the

and the pink one represents joy, the joy we experience as the celebration of Christmas approaches.

Often times an advent wreath also has a white candle in the centre, a Christ candle that reminds us that Christ is the light of the world.

Week 1 – Expectation – wait in expectation for Christmas as we prepare our hearts.

Week 2 – Hope – we still wait in hope that Jesus will become a bigger part of our lives; our prayers guide us to treat others as we are called to.

Week 3 - Joy - we are almost there – Christmas nears as we continue our preparations; this is a time to think of Mary and the joy she experienced when she said yes to the Angel Gabriel.

Week 4 – Peace – we experience peace through celebration, knowing Jesus, as our role model, is ever present.
